

Results of the June 20th T-Hunt held at Desert Bloom Park that was hosted by Larry, KG7NEP and Dan, KM7AKK; thank you both.

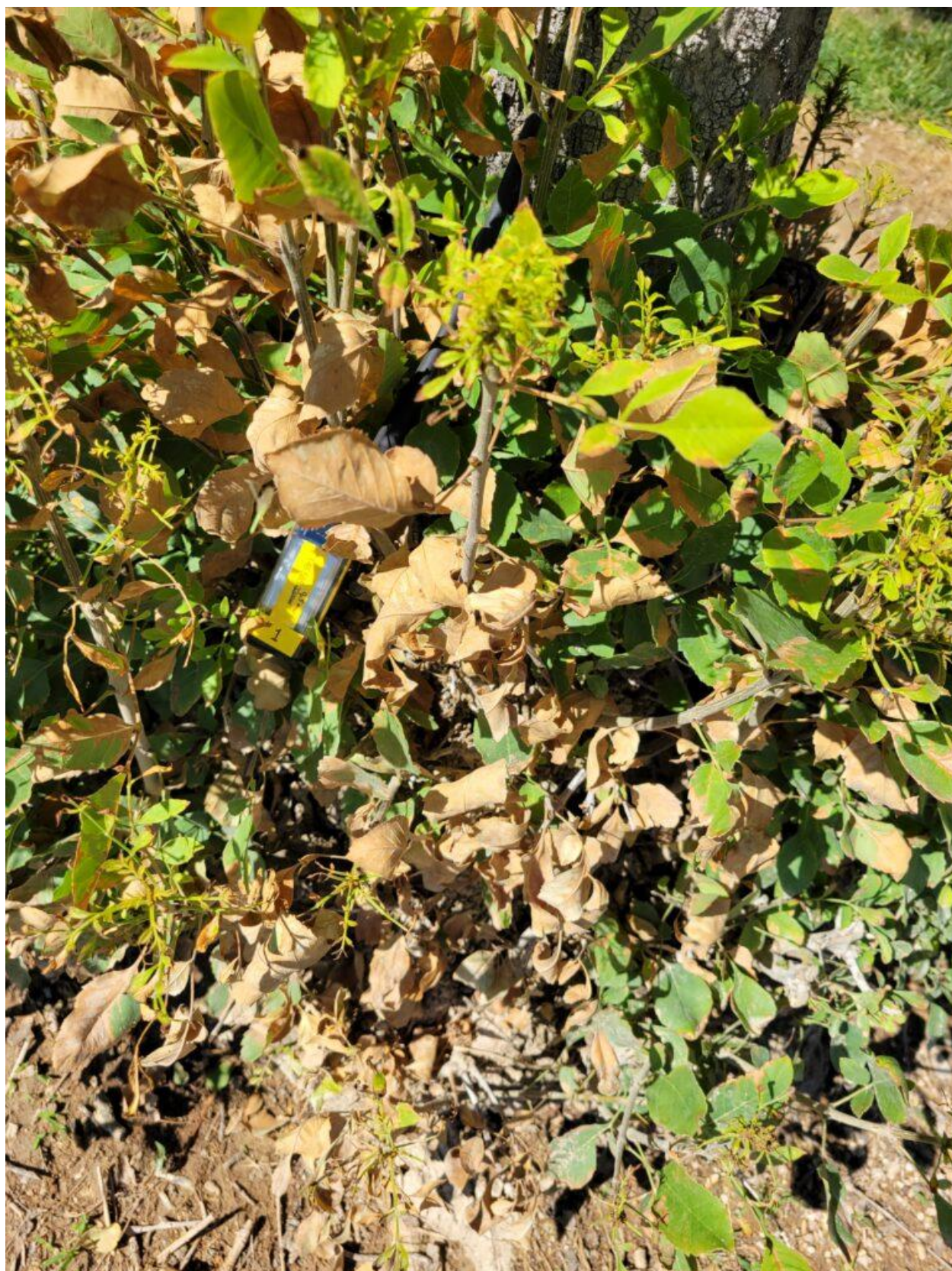
